


The Auglaize County Libraries are here for you. How can the public library help you? We're so glad you asked.



Take Your Class to the Library

Schedule a field trip to the library for your class or grade. Best suited for 1 team or 2-3 classes at a time. Topics can vary & can be requested via email. See back page for more info. *Please schedule class trips at least 2 weeks in advance.

includes library tour, Summer Reading talk, story or scavenger hunt, & free/play time



may include tour, library services talk, story, scavenger hunt, or free time by request



Bring the Library to Your Class

Request a librarian to visit your classroom or grade. Best suited for 1 class at a time per classroom. Topics can vary & can be requested. Submit requests via email.

STORY TIME VISIT

We'll host a 20-30 min. storytime in your classroom around a theme tailored to your grade.

eBOOK ACCESS CLASS

A library staff member can teach your class how to access our eResources (eBooks, eMedia, etc.) on their phones or computers in your classroom.



Library Cards for Your Students

A library card is the key to information and adventure for young people. It is one of the most valuable things a child can own. It allows them to check out books, movies, music, and much more, PLUS immediate access to electronic resources and eBooks. To obtain cards for your students, each child must have a parent fill out & sign a Library Card Application.

Applications are available to download & print from our website at <u>www.auglaizelibraries.org/teachers</u>. Gather completed applications and submit them to the Library. Library cards will then be created for each child and can be sent back to your classroom for distribution. New cards can be picked up during a field trip as long as forms have been submitted at least one week before visit. Library cards (and even replacement cards!) are free, but parental permission is required as any material late fees or replacement costs will then be the parent's responsibility.

Teacher Loans

Teachers at all local schools, daycare instructors, & homeschool teachers are welcome to sign up for a Teacher Card which allows users to borrow materials for 56-days instead of the usual 28. You can also request a Classroom Collection for your students (a grade-appropriate selection of 10-30 books) to make life easier. Submit your request online under the Teacher tab on our website & you can even pick them up through the drive thru!
